Congratulations on your student being part of **Disney High School Musical** and welcome to theatre at Woodbury High School! We thank you ahead of time for your support and time. As a parent of a cast or crew member, we rely on you to help us with a number of tasks from now through the end of the show.

The Booster organization supports the directors, crew, families, and students involved in Woodbury High School Theatre which includes the Fall Musical, the One Act Play, and the Spring Play.

We are excited for you to meet our entire creative team! Marcie Berglund is the director of our fall musical. Our own Daryl Timmer is the vocal director and Matt Shervey is the director of our live orchestra. Heather Fisher is back as our choreographer. Ursula Bowden is returning as our set designer. Norm Tiedemann is back as our technical director, and Katie Roche is returning to do costumes again.

We have participated in the Hennepin Theatre Trust Spotlight Award Program for the past two years. We have received several awards and a number of our students got to perform on stage at the Orpheum and State theatres. We are excited to participate in the Spotlight Program again this year! Our goal is an Outstanding Overall Production Award so that our entire cast gets to sing a medley on stage!

We rely on parent volunteers to support our show in a variety of ways. Please see the next page for different volunteer opportunities!

Volunteer Opportunities

House Manager

- Arrive one hour before show time.
- Will remain in cafeteria throughout show.
- Answer questions and keep it quiet. Bring a book!

Tickets

- Two volunteers are needed for each show.
- Please arrive 70 minutes before show.
- This is best done on a night when you do not have tickets for the show since you will be asked to stay 20-30 minutes after the start of the show.

Concessions

- Six volunteers are needed for each show.
- Three will need to come 75 minutes before the show starts to help set up tables, make popcorn and sell concessions before the show.
- When the show begins, the stand will be closed.
- All six need to leave the show 15 minutes before intermission to prepare for intermission.
- After intermission, there is a brief clean-up performed by the later three.

Ushers

- Four volunteers are needed for each show.
- Please arrive 45 minutes before the show starts.
- Hand out program and help people find seats if needed.
- During show please remain at the doors during the show to seat latecomers and control access so the actors are not disturbed by the noise of the door opening and closing.
- During intermission remind patrons that food or beverages (except water) are not allowed in the auditorium.

Donation Table (Open position)

- Responsible for greeting guests and collecting the items they may bring for service project. Please pack up the donated items and store in the auditorium after the show.

Stargrams

- Four volunteers are needed for each show.
- Please arrive 30 minutes before the show.
- When the show begins, the stand will be closed.
- You will leave the show before intermission to be ready to sell during intermission..
- Younger siblings can help as runners.

Backstage Parents

- Two volunteers are needed for each show.
- Arrive 20 minutes before the show. This is a pretty simple job, you might want to bring a book.
- You are here primarily in case an emergency should arise. You might also zip a zipper, button a button, or make sure things stay quiet off stage.
- Volunteers stay in the hallways with the actors to provide assistance and keep it quiet.

Before/After performances:

Meal Assistance:

1. Tech week. Help set up, serve, guard hallways, and clean up after cast meals.
2. Donate a dessert or water

Ticket Sales: Multiple dates. Some evenings, some during day.

Sewing Assistance: Help with sewing of costumes and other simple sewing tasks.

Set Construction: Parent help needed with set construction including building and painting.

Set Strike: Assist the directors in overseeing set strike.

DO NOT purchase tickets on nights that you volunteer for House Manager, Tickets, Concessions, Usher, Star Grams, or Back Stage Parent.

We try to reserve seating in the back for our volunteers during the show as space & position permits.

Opening Night Reception

We welcome you to an Opening Night Reception following the November 13th performance.

This event is still in the planning stages and we will need many volunteers for planning, decorating, and serving. We are planning on serving desserts and refreshments.

Ticket Information

Tickets to Disney High School Musical may be purchased in two different ways.

Online Ordering Information

- Tickets will be available online beginning October 1.
- Payment this year will be through Vendini. Funds are directed to the school district. The WHS Theatre Boosters **Do Not** receive any funds from ticket sales.
- **WHS Theatre Booster Members** will receive preferential ticket fulfillment prior to tickets being available to the general public.
- **All online tickets will be held at will-call.**

In-Person Ticket Purchase

- Tickets will be sold in person at the high school on dates and times to be determined. Watch out for an email for those dates and times.
- One hour before each performance as tickets are available.

Fees

To clarify any potential confusion about the fees that go along with being part of a WHS Theatre production, we have laid out the following guide:

Payment # 1: To District 833

- **District 833 Activity Fee: \$65.00 required fee, payable by check to WHS.**
- Please register your student for the fall musical online at www.whsactivities.org. Note this is a different website from the Boosters website. Scholarships are available. **Payment is by check to WHS; it CANNOT be made online.** Contact the Activities Office for more information.

Payment # 2: To WHS Theatre Boosters

- The following fees help offset costs of production that the Boosters cover.
- **Cast and Crew Meals:** The Boosters buy four meals for each member of the cast and crew from local restaurants during Tech Week. The cost of this is \$24.00. Vegetarian options are available.
- **T-Shirts:** T-Shirts are optional but we will be wearing the t-shirts for a cast and crew photograph for the program. Kids who do not purchase a t-shirt will be asked to wear a similar colored shirt for the photograph.
- **Donations:** The Boosters receive no revenue from ticket sales and no funding from the school district. Instead of asking kids to do fundraising, we ask each family that is able to do so to make a contribution. As a thank you, families that make a contribution of \$25.00 or more will receive a DVD of professional photographs of the cast, crew, and orchestra during production and performances.
- **Royal Theatre Spirit Wear:** Back this year! Show your pride with our new clothing items.
